Nonferrous Materials

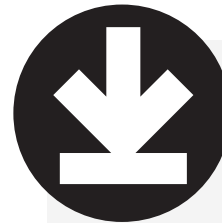
- Copper wire, piping, tubing and sheets
- Aluminium extrusions, wheels, rims, cans, pots and pans
- Brass scrap including solids and turnings
- Stainless steel sinks, pipes, rods and sheets
- Tin, zinc, lead and nickel items

Ferrous Metals

- Car bodies
- Iron and cast iron
- Heavy gauge steel
- Light gauge steel
- White goods
- Machinery
- Miscellaneous scrap metals

Household goods

- White goods
- Brass scrap
- Metal pots and pans
- Copper piping
- Radiators
- Aluminium cans
- Stainless steel products
- Car bodies, radios and batteries



The items we **don't** purchase

- Mercury
- Radioactive metals, including uranium and plutonium
- Contaminated cans, like paint and motor oil cans
- Certain household equipment, like gas tanks and tyres
